The 1st Meeting We are Online!

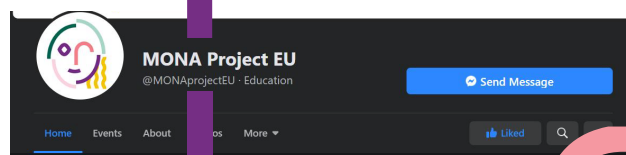
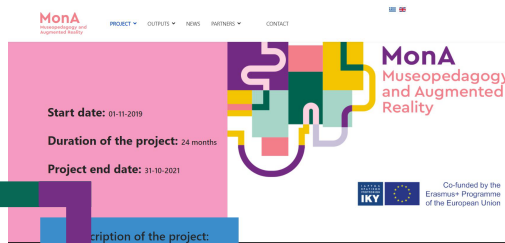
The Kick-off Meeting took place the on the 16th and 17th of December, at the Research Center-Tsitsanis Museum in Trikala, Greece.
